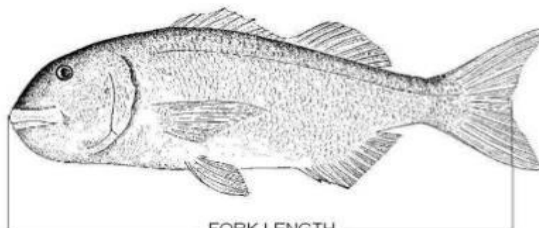


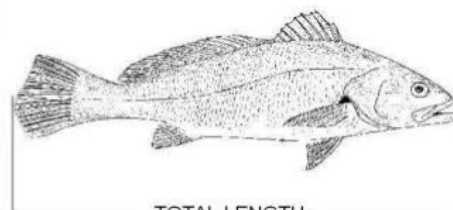


## Criteria & rules

- All edible species to be targeted, no shark catches will be accepted or considered for any prizes.
- Only saltwater species, no freshwater species will be considered.
- Bag and size limits must be strictly adhered to.
- Must have a valid fishing license in your name.
- Only fish caught from the side with a rod and reel will be considered, no fishing from boats, jet ski's, drones, deep sea or any other form of fishing is allowed.
- U may fish from the beach and rocks as well as any river within the designated area of fishing (Hartenbos, Groot Brak & Klein Brak rivers).
- A DuneSeven tag with your personal number will be issued to u when u register to be used on all proof of your catches (to be collected at the DuneSeven shop in Voorbaai, Mossel Bay)
- U will also receive a score card with your registered number that u must complete with your catches indicating the species, length, date and place caught, released or not as well as a witness signature..
- Your score card and tag need to be dropped of at the DuneSeven shop not later than 12:00pm on the last day of the competition (27 December 2022) Your tag will also go into the bin to make u a possible winner in one of the many lucky draw prizes.
- U need to submit a picture with your fish on a measuring tape clearly showing the length of the fish and your tag with your number next to the fish all on the same pic.
- U need to submit a second picture of yourself holding your fish.
- U need to submit a video no longer than 10 seconds of all fish released.
- The pictures of your catches will be cross checked to your score card and verified by the organisers when u drop off your score card and tag.
- You have to WhatsApp your pictures of your fish with your full name as registered for the competition.
